The functions of the product in kind shall prevail. Functional differences due to product upgrades are subject to no prior notice.

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SAFETY WARNINGS

 Please read and understand the following precautions carefully before using this product, and keep the Manual properly for future inquiry.

The device shall be kept in a well-ventilated environment.

- No vent holes shall be covered with items such as newspapers, tablecloths and curtains that may impede ventilation.
- Do not place exposed flame sources, such as lit candles, on the device.

The device shall not be exposed to drops or splashes, and no liquid filled objects such as vases shall be placed on the device.

To prevent tipping hazards, make sure that all edges of the device within the bracket, and do not place the device on any unstable or non-weight bearing carts, racks or tables.

The device must be securely secured to the wall by professionals.

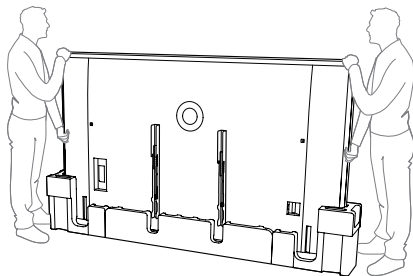

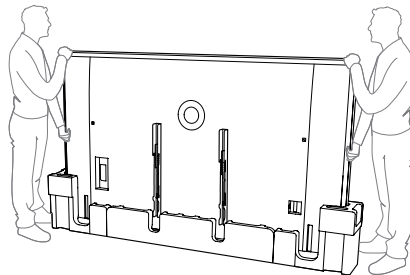

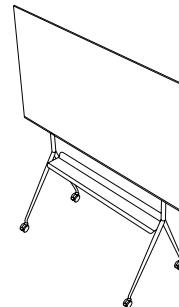

VESA Hole Pattern Diagram



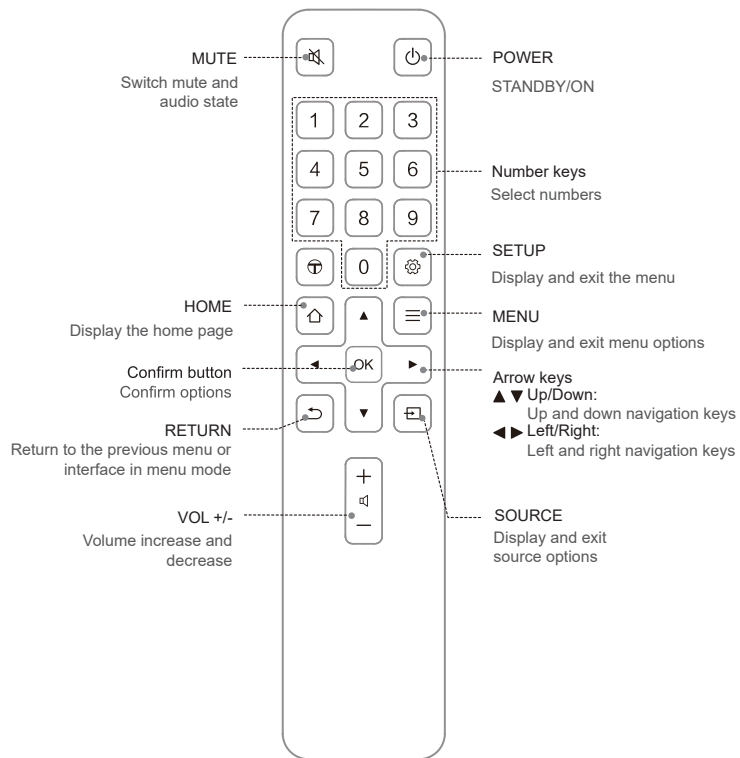

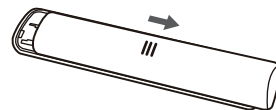

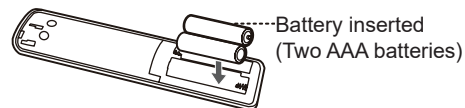
Schematic Diagram of Remote Control



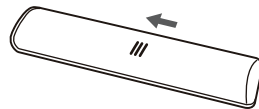
Installation Diagram of Remote Control Batteries

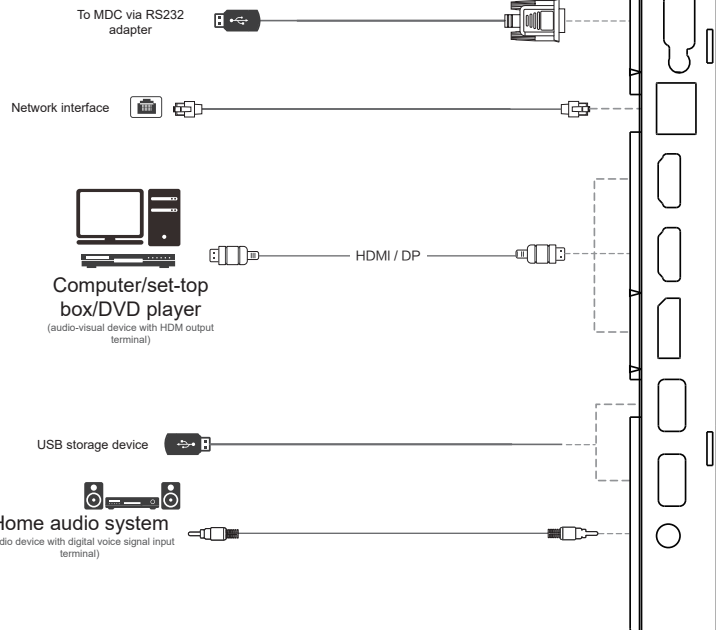
■ REMOTE CONTROL KEYS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Precautions for use of remote control:

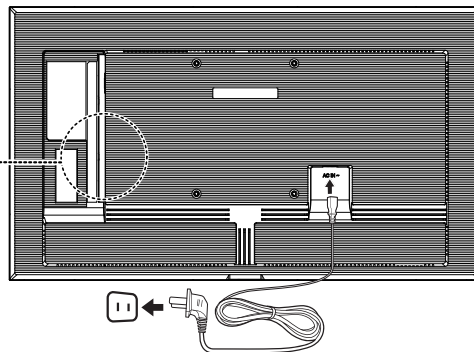
- When operating the main unit with the remote control, aim at the screen's reception area. If the remote control is unresponsive, you can pull down the key box and direct the box for remote operation. If there is an obstacle between the main unit and the remote control, it may result in malfunction.
 - To ensure optimal performance of the remote control, please replace the battery immediately if abnormal operation is found after long-time use of the battery.
 - Do not mix new and old batteries or batteries of different types.
 - When the battery power is low, it may leak electrolytes, which can damage the remote control. Please replace the battery immediately once it is found that the power is low or the remote control does not work.
 - If the remote control is not used for a long time, please take out the battery to prevent electrolyte leakage from the battery.
 - When the remote control is not in use, please store it in a cool and dry place. Avoid direct sunlight, exposure to heat, and storing it in damp areas.
- The system can activate the remote control lock, which will prevent infrared remote control from operating the device. To unlock, please try the following operations:
 1. Press the "1003" button followed by the "OK" button. After seeing the prompt to unlock the remote control, attempt to operate it.
 2. Press the "Up/Down/Left/Right" button followed by the "OK" button. After seeing the prompt to unlock the remote control, attempt to operate it.

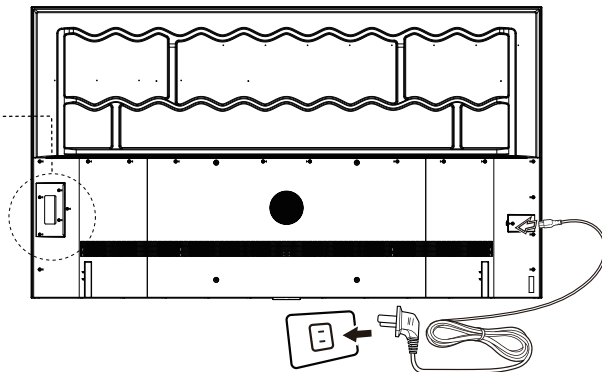

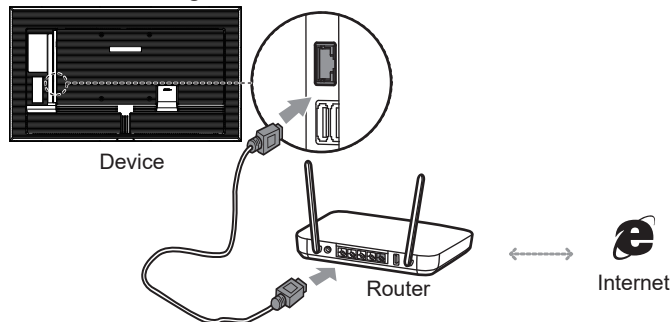

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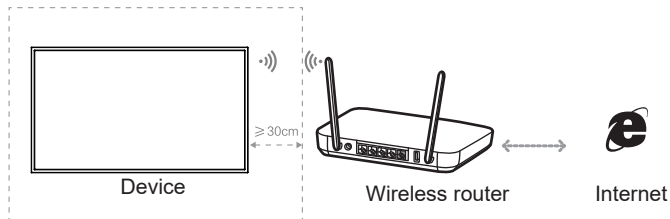

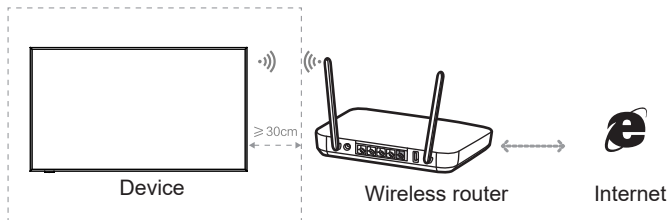

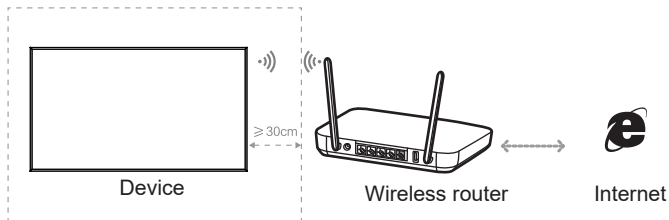

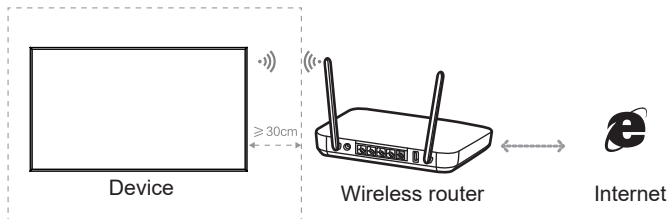

■ BASIC FUNCTIONS OF DEVICE

- Startup

Connect the AC power supply, and the device will start up automatically. When the device is on standby, press the ⏻ button on the remote control or device to start up the device.

- Shutdown

When the device is turned on, short press the ⏻ button on the remote control to enter the standby state; short press the Standby button on the device to enter the standby state.

Note: In case of power failure or out-of-service for a long time, please unplug the power cord from the socket in time.

- Function entry

Enter the home page of the device, and press the Left/Right button on the remote control to select different function entries.

When the focus of the remote control moves to these function entries, relevant applications will be displayed on the interface.

■ MULTIMEDIA, NETWORK DOWNLOAD FUNCTION QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. What should I pay attention to in software upgrade?

A: (1) Do not power off during the upgrade process; (2) Do not use the remote control for any operation during the upgrade process; (3) The upgrade process may take a long time (generally about 5 minutes), but the process of downloading the upgrade APK through the network is affected by the network, so it cannot be accurately estimated, so you need to wait patiently.

2. Why is there no obvious change after the software upgrade?

A: Sometimes the software upgrade is to add new functions, and sometimes it is to improve the performance of the device. Therefore, the content of each upgrade is different. After the upgrade, new functions may be added and there are obvious changes in the interface. Or there may be no changes in the interface and no added functions, but only improved performance.

3. What if I accidentally touch the power supply during the upgrade process and terminate the upgrade?

A: Specific treatment methods: if there is a USB disk inserted in the device, please do not remove it, with the USB disk restart, should be able to upgrade; If you didn't start the upgrade with the USB disk, you also need to turn off the device and restart it to see whether it is normal; If you still can't upgrade again, please contact the customer service center.

4. Why does the USB device is not detected when the USB drive is plugged in?

A: It may be because the mobile hard disk is faulty or the power supply is insufficient. If it is a mobile hard disk fault, the mobile hard disk needs to access to the computer, then repair the mobile hard disk. Specific steps: first, find the disk on the computer, right-click the mobile hard disk, select "properties" in the pop-up box, and then select "tools". After that, begin to repair the selected mobile hard disk or USB disk. Secondly, if the mobile hard disk power supply is insufficient (the mobile hard disk will have, "click" sound), it will cause the hard disk cannot work normally. A voltage of 5V and current of 500MA-700MA are required to operate USB devices. If the power supply is insufficient, it will cause to read/write errors or even unrecognizable on the mobile hard drive. The device will work fine with USB in this range. If a power shortage occurs, plug both plugs from one end of the USB cable into the USB portal the same time to enhance the power supply. In addition, you can also use an external power supply (please pay attention to choose a suitable model). Please note that you must start the machine before inserting the USB disk.

❑ FAULT ANALYSIS AND TROUBLESHOOTING HDMI

HDMI Failure

1. Check whether the connection cable from the device to the device is plugged in place or re-plug the HDMI cable.
2. Check whether the resolution of the external device meets the requirements of the device.

No Picture No Sound

The power outlet switch is not turned on.
Poor connect of power line.
Check the signal source.

The Image Has Messy Ripples

Usually cause by local interference. Such as cars, fluorescent lamps, hair dryers, etc.

No Color

A black screen in computer mode (that is, when it is used as a computer monitor) may be due to the unrecognizable resolution set by the computer. It is recommended to change to the optimal resolution or other Windows system standard resolutions.

Normal Picture, No Sound

Maybe the volume is not turned on, press the volume + key: if there is no physical volume key, adjust the volume in the system settings.

With Sound But No Picture

Adjust the brightness analog amount.

Spark Interference

Black dots, horizontal stripes or images appear to sway and flap. These phenomena are often cause by the ignition system, neon lights, the interference of electric drill or other electronic device.
